WINDSOR, ON, April 22, 2008 – Experience the world's most advanced vibration exercise technology. Local developer WAVE Manufacturing Inc. will be on-site at this year's Windsor Technology Expo 2008, April 23 from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. and April 24 from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Headquartered in Windsor, Ontario, the WAVE organization is a global leader in the development of whole-body advanced vibration exercise technology.

The company's advancements have included bringing pure vibrations to the industry. In fact, its vibrations are pure vertical unlike competing vibration plates which offer uncontrolled vibration with torsion distortion. WAVE has also brought innovations to its industry that is quickly making its machine the preferred vibration plate for research into such ailments as Osteoporosis.

WAVE's patent-pending automatic calibration adjusts the machine to compensate for the weight of its users. Vibration plates are resistance exercise machines that work by pushing the user's body upwards – two to four millimetres – against gravity. Because WAVE technology compensates for the user's weight, the vibration experience is universal – a key requirement for research. Most competing machines are also not able to handle anything but fit people. The WAVE's vibration plate can handle 1,500 lbs. No other manufacturer has developed such an advanced machine, giving WAVE global technology leadership.

WAVE is also making inroads in competitive sports performance training.

"Several of the top athletes in Canada currently train on our whole-body vibration machine," says Harmeet Kuner, President, WAVE Manufacturing. "This includes such Windsor athletes as Canadian bantamweight boxing champion Andrew Kooner, Megan Muscat, an up-and-coming local Paralympic track and field athlete, and mixed martial arts fighter Chuck Mady."

WAVE, which is an acronym for Whole-body Advanced Vibration Exercise, came into being when the company's founders could not find a vibration plate on the market suitable for clinical use. The result is a significant advance in technology.

One unique distinguishing feature of the WAVE plate is its size. The plate measures 30 by 36 inches allowing a wide variety of exercises to be accomplished without the fear of tipping the platform.

Whole-body vibration represents the perfect opportunity for companies to explore corporate fitness and engage in a very advanced alternative exercise activity or complement traditional resistance and cardio training. Vibration exercise is non-strenuous – which is why it is ideal for rehabilitation – does not require any special clothing, and takes 15 minutes, three times a week.
